

Veterinary regulations:

Every dog must have a veterinary certificate and must be vaccinated against rabies at least 21 days before the show and the vaccination can be no longer than 3 years old. All the time during the show the owners must supervise their dogs / take care of the dogs so that they do not cause any damage to other dogs or humans/.

Common regulations.

The dog show is organized according to the dog show rules of the FCI and ČMKU.

The exhibitors are obliged to abide with the provisions of the FCI, show regulations, these propositions, and the instructions of the Show Committee, to which they bind themselves by submitting the entry form.

In case the show does not take place for objective reasons, the fees would be used for covering the show preparation expenses.

By signing and submitting the entry form the exhibitor agrees to the publication of his name and address in the show catalogue and on the web page of the club.

By submitting your entry application, you agree with the terms of EP 2016/679 about personal information display for the needs of 51st C.S.

Biting dogs must have muzzles.

The reception of your dog to the show will be confirmed by a letter.

In the class of babies and puppies you do not need to send the copy of the pedigree with the entry form.

You must pay the show fee even if your accepted dog does not participate at the show. Selling of puppies is completely prohibited at the show place.

The division of the circles and the appointment of the judges depends on the number of exhibitors.

Protest:

Protest the judges' decisions (title or placement) is not allowed. The exhibitor can just appeal formally by raising objections (e.g. the break of the show order), which must be done in a written form. When raising objections, you must deposit 90,- Euros. This sum will not be returned if your protest is qualified as unsubstantiated.

Prizes:

Every exhibitor will be handed over the judge's decision and a certificate in the circle. Record in the pedigree will be written in the circle too. The first four dogs in every class obtain a cup or a prize at the end of the procession.
